Following a series of community workshops and a period of public consultation, FAIRsFAIR published its **Framework for assessing FAIR Services**<sup>1</sup> in August 2021. The framework aims to help service providers assess how FAIR-enabling their current practices are and provides practical guidance on areas where improvements might be made.
